

# Lettuce necrotic yellows virus discussion

An outbreak of lettuce necrotic yellows virus was detected in the Werribee South area in late January following a higher than usual aphid count. The positive detection was made through the Hort Innovation Area Wide Management project, from mixed infection samples of Mirafiori lettuce big-vein virus, Lettuce necrotic yellows virus and Lettuce big-vein associated virus.
